## Revised Risk Assessment Arrangements for next week.

### Start and end times

We have identified that we have more than enough time and space between KS1 and KS2 start and end times that we can reduce these slightly to help parents with multiple siblings in school.

Therefore from Monday 14th September

**EYFS, Y1, Y2, and Y3** will continue to **start at 8.30am** and **end at 3.00 pm**, but **Y4, Y5, and Y6** will now **start at 8.45am** and **end at 3.15pm**

We hope this new arrangement will cut down on the amount of time that parents need to wait for younger siblings

### One Way System

The one way system will remain in place for parents and carers to help reinforce social distancing. Please make sure you use the correct entrance and exit to ensure adults can social distance as instructed by the government.

### PE

On children's PE days please send them to school in their PE kit. They do not need to bring a change of clothes. Make sure children are warm enough as we may do PE outside.

### Class Dojo

Over the period of full lockdown we had great success with online learning through Class Dojo. It proved to be a fantastic way to communicate with children and families instantly and keep you all up to date with the plans for reopening

We plan to carry on using Class Dojo to communicate updates and support homework.

We are also required to provide online learning for any child who is isolating and will be doing so through Class Dojo.

Therefore we ask any parents or carers who are yet to sign up to Class Dojo to do so. Your child's class teacher will be sending home details of how to do this, or you can contact the school office by telephone and they will be happy to help you.

### Attendance

We have been instructed to reinstate the Attendance Policy in line with government guidance. Therefore we expect 97% or better attendance from all children. This is to ensure we start to close the gap in learning that children have experienced over lock down. There are rewards for children in school for good attendance.
