### **Our Consequence System**

Warning: Rule Reminder

C1: Recorded warning.

C2: Further recorded warning

C3: 5 minutes time out to think about behaviour

C4 : Playtime or Lunch time detention and miss after school club. Parents informed.

C5: Half a day isolation. Lunchtime detention. No after school club. Parents informed.

C6- Possible FTE exclusion.

- We expect everyone in our academy to respect our rules and try to set a good example. Some children might find it hard to follow our rules. We help those children in different ways so that they can earn Dojos.
- We should try to behave well at all times. During the academy day this means playtimes and lunchtimes.
- We understand the importance of behaving well on academy trips and with visitors, so that people outside our academy can see that we make the right choices and do our best.
